- Conducted the **Annual Meeting** with a talk by Birgit Kibelka and Marjorie White entitled "What Makes Mountain Brook Mountain Brook" and celebrated the publication of Mountain Brook-A Historic American Landscape at the Birmingham Botanical Gardens.
- Mounted the exhibition *Perfectly Planned: Mountain Brook Roads and Scenic Views* at the Emmet O'Neal Library.
- Hosted the annual Heritage Society Luncheon at Mountain Brook Club.
- Continued to grow **Grandmother's Garden** using heirloom plants and practices, with the help of the Alabama Cooperative Extension System and Master Gardeners. Conducted the annual Spring Equinox Plowing Party. The demonstration home garden of kitchen and medicinal herbs, flowers and vegetables is open to the public year round.
